We acknowledge the great mystery of the Holy Trinity the three persons in the one God. We know God as the Father who created the world and everything in it, including ourselves; we profess our faith in Jesus as the God who lived, died, and rose again to save us; and we honour God the Holy Spirit who lives within us and calls us to have an intimate relationship with our God, and a holy relationship with our brothers and sisters in Christ. Making the Sign of the Cross with faith, reverence, and devotion is the best way to being our own personal celebration of the Mass. It focuses our attention on who we are in relationship with God and with one another.

Our Second Reading reminds us that priests are chosen from among the People of God, to help us, their brothers and sisters, in our weakness and our uncertainty, in our relationship with the Lord. We pray for the men in our parish communities who are being called to serve the Church as priests of this diocese.

Indulgences for the Holy Souls.

From 12 o'clock noon on the 1st November until midnight on 2 November all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father & Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice), can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or Oratory and there reciting one Our Father & the Apostles' Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following the 1 November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 - 8 November.

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions one per day from 1 - 8 November. The conditions above also apply for this.
